1 Planning

- 1.1 P2010 0777 Display 2 x internally illuminated fascia signs and 1 internally illuminated hanging sign, and replace 2 x opening/branch name plates, and install new ATM and security camera at Barclays Bank plc. Malvern House.

- 1.2 P2010 0771 Erection of a single dwelling at Cambrian Woollen Mill.

- 1.3 P2010 0773 Erection of a single dwelling at Cambrian Woollen Mill

Both the planning applications for the Cambrian Mill were rejected for the following reasons:

- a The site is outside the Unitary Development Area
- b There is no need for the dwellings, there already being an abundance of plots and properties within the UDA.
- c The car parks are NOT vacant but are in regular use.

Copies of letters sent to PCC Planning Department objecting to the plans were presented. From these letters it appears there is a problem with the Bridal Path being amalgamated into the car park, so vehicles are now parking across the Bridal Way. Clerk to write to PCC Rights of Way Department.
