

Cyngor Tref Llanwrtyd Town Council

Notes of Special Meeting held Tuesday June 28th 2011 at 6.30pm in the Council Chamber, War Memorial Institute.

Present

Councillors Prichard, Newman, Price, Burton and Thomas.

1 Apologies

Councillors James, Stocker, Rowlands, B Jones and Van-Rees.

2 Camping on Dolwen Field – allocation of camping space and collection of money. It was noted that Green Events had collected the camping money for the Man v Horse event, and that this money is currently with Bernice Benton who is to give this money to the town council.

Suggestions have previously been made that event organisers hire the field and pavilion facilities at a flat rate, that they are then responsible for allocating camping space and collecting money. Under the circumstances it was decided this would be most appropriate and the arrangements will be as follows:

Events organisers will apply to the town council to use the field and pavilion facilities at a given date/s

The organisers will pay in advance a flat rate of £50 per day to cover insurance, electricity etc

A £20 deposit will also be charged with each booking, which will be refunded providing the facilities are left clean and in good order to the satisfaction of the town council

Organisers will be responsible for ensuring the field and pavilion are left in good clean order

Organisers will be responsible for collecting camping money, which they will keep

The clerk said she would be away from June 30th to July 5th, and as the next event is July 9th and 10th, she would not be able to write to organisers in time. Cllr Prichard said she would notify the Stonecroft Inn and it will then be followed up in writing.

Events organisers are Green Events, Stonecroft Inn, Red Kite Events, Green Dragon Events with a copy to Friends of TIC.

3 Changes in Mail Delivery - it has been publicised that the sorting office has now moved to Llandrindod Wells making postal deliveries later by at least an hour. Also should anyone have a mail item to collect they would now have to make a round trip in excess of 40 miles to collect their packet. Anything posted after the last collection on Fridays will not leave Builth Wells until noon on Mondays. Cllr Prichard had tried to make telephone contact with Euan Davies without success, so had written to him asking him to make contact. Cllr Newman said her husband had also written to outline the difficulties for him as a businessman. Cllr B Jones had left a message with the clerk to say one of her concerns is the increase in work load given to post men meaning that they have to try and get round quicker. This is a significant health and safety issue on our narrow country roads. This to be an agenda item at the July meeting.

4 QE2 Fields in Trust Deed of Dedication – the deed, plan of the area and copy of the conveyance document has been sent, however members were asked to consider whether they want to the field to have charitable status. A discussion took place, the clerk had asked for advice from Wyn Richard PCC and Del Morgan OVW, Wyn said he had no expertise in this area. The clerk will make further enquiries and report back at the July meeting.

5 Any Other Business

5.1 Cllr Price said he had spoken with Claire Sterry of PAVO re funding for the pavilion. A meeting of the Development Committee is to be called for Monday July 11th at 7pm, Cllr Price will email members of the group.

5.2 Cllr Van-Rees had sent a message that he would be speaking with Gareth Hopkins about the road closure as he feels not enough notice was given.

5.3 Cllr Prichard will make suggestions for a presentation on hydroelectricity.
